

Hazardous Waste Label

Hazardous waste label is not needed if original material is in original container.

EHSA Online Pickup Request will generate Hazardous Waste Labels. If unable, print this label, complete, and label the chemical waste container(s) when accumulation begins.

Waste container must be in good shape and compatible with the waste it holds.

Do NOT use formulas, trade names, or abbreviations on the label. Label must show 100% of constituents.

Secondary containment must be used for waste. Waste must be stored according to chemical compatibility.

Allow room in waste container for expansion; do not fill to the top.

Do not leave funnel in container. Keep container closed except when adding waste.

Do not accumulate > 55 gallons of waste in a lab.
